

8 Considerations When Choosing Your ERP System

How to find an ERP system that solves problems instead of creating them



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A make-or-break decision

Whether you're a small organization or a multinational with offices on five continents, your ERP system has the potential to make life easier and more productive for you and your employees—if you choose the right system.

Sort your strategy first

Before you start shopping for an ERP system, it's worth agreeing on your organization's ERP strategy. Your ERP strategy will inform the choice of modules, infrastructure requirements and other elements of your ERP implementation, and should be based on your business objectives. Simply put, a well thought-out ERP strategy will help lower the time-to-value of your ERP system, and can increase ROI compared to implementations without a strategy.
